



10 Things (Teachers Can Do

To Help Under-Resourced Children Learn

- Mediate, mediate, mediate (Explain not only WHAT they need to do, but also WHY and HOW to do it).
- Build a relationship of mutual respect with each student.
- Communicate to parents the need to talk to their children.
- Connect lessons to students' lives and interests.
- Help students reflect on the future.
- Explain that we were not born with a set amount of intelligence. Our brains grow every time we use them.
- Make students aware of their own, personal growth. Point out to them what they can do now that they couldn't do a week (month, etc.) ago.
- Focus frequently on the beauty and power of words.
- As often as possible, give students choices.
- Teach processes.


